Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 3 have been enjoying their 'Animals, including Humans' topic in their science lessons this term and they have a great opportunity to extend their learning by going on an educational visit to Bishops Wood Outdoor Education Centre in Stourport on Severn.

The class will explore different habitats, and discover what lives there. They will identify what they have caught using simple classification keys and discover how they move, breathe, and are adapted to their habitat. Pupils will discover what producers, predators and prey are and recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways.

Our trip will be on Thursday 4th November. We will be leaving school promptly at 9:00am and be returning by 3.30pm. Children will need to wear their school uniform and, depending on the weather, they will need to have a coat. Please could you send a packed lunch (contact the Deli if needed) and a water bottle that is clearly labelled with your child's name. Bishops Wood operate a waste free lunch, so please send children with a lunch that will produce as little throw away packaging as possible (eg an apple, rather than apple slices in a plastic packet. This will be great incidental learning for the children.

The cost of the trip will be £20 per child. This includes the cost of the teaching sessions and the transport. A link to an online form will follow this letter. Please complete it and send in payment in either cash or cheque (made payable to Worcestershire County Council) by Monday 1st November.
