Dear Parents & Carers,

As part of our half term topic, 'Stone Age to Iron Age', I have planned a trip to Bredon Hill. This is planned to take place on the 17th February, weather permitting. The children will be able to make their learning real and see the remains of an Iron Age Hill Fort. I have booked Nina O'Hare, LA Community Archaeologist, for that morning and she will lead the educational session. As we will have to pay for Nina's time, we are requesting a £3 contribution from each child, to go towards the cost.

This trip will then be used to inform future History lessons, where the children will design their own Hill Fort, and also English lessons too.

We will leave at 9:15am and be back around lunch time. We ask that children bring a pack lunch with them. If your child has a hot school meal this can be changed to a pack lunch provided by the Deli.
