**Dear Parents & Carers,**

As part of this half term's topic, 'Stone Age to Iron Age', I have planned a trip to Bredon Hill. This is planned to take place on the 1st February, weather permitting. The children will be able to make their learning real and see the remains of an Iron Age hill fort.

I have booked Nina O'Hare, LA Community Archaeologist, for that morning and she will lead the educational session. As we will have to pay for Nina's time and the coach, we are requesting £7 from each child, to go towards the cost. This trip will then be used to inform future History lessons, where the children will design their own hill fort. We will also use this experience in English lessons too. Please send the money in to the office in an envelope with your child's name on it and labelled 'Bredon Hill Trip'.

We will leave school at 9:15am and be back around lunch time. We ask that children have a pack lunch on that day. If your child has a hot school meal this can be changed to a pack lunch provided by the Deli.

Your child should please come to school in their own clothes on that day. They will need to be appropriately dressed according for the weather. As it is cold and may be muddy in places, walking boots/wellington boots, sensible clothing and an emergency change of clothes with a carrier bag for wet clothes are essential.
